How do we help?

Two orphanages and a home for elderly people provide lodging for the homeless. The new orphanage for boys was completed in March 2017.



Drinking water is not accessible to everyone in India, but now 38 groundwater wells supply hundreds of families with clean water close to their home.



A kindergarten helps to prepare children for primary school. The foundation finances the studies of young women and men.



Our program provides sponsors for nearly 40 children.
